

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy governs the way the Audioteka collects, uses and discloses information gathered from its users.

Personal identification data

Audioteka can collect personal information which is used for identification of the users who benefit from the services, functions or app resources offered to them.

If the User wishes to use paid content of Audioteka, relevant payments must be made and will be collected exclusively by external electronic payment service providers, such as PayPal or Adyen, who offer relevant security measures.

Users can use Audioteka via an individual or anonymous account. Having an anonymous account does not prevent your personal data from being processed.

Protecting privacy of minors

Protection of the privacy of minors is particularly important. For this reason, no part of this Service is intended for young people under 13 years old.

Sharing personal data

We do not sell, share or provide information collected by us to other entities, unless the obligation of sharing such information results from general provisions of the law.

Cookies – information on the end device

Audioteka may collect and analyse non-personal information on the type, model of the device, its available memory, advertising ID and all technical information concerning the user, his/her operating system and other similar information. Audioteka may collect cookies containing the above-mentioned information. The information will be stored in order to improve the System's operation and to ensure that personalised offers can be addressed to the user in an automatic manner.

Pursuant to Article 173 section 1 item 2 in conjunction with Article 173 section 2 of the Telecommunication Law, if you do not want cookies to be stored in your device's memory, you should modify your settings accordingly. Your use of a configuration allowing for the cookie use means that you agree to that.

Who is the controller of your personal data?

The controller of your personal data is Audioteka S.A. with its registered office in Warsaw (02-673) at ul. 12 Konstruktorska ("Audioteka").

What is the purpose and basis for us to process your data?

Your personal data will be processed in order to enable the use of services provided by Audioteka S.A. and for Audioteka's marketing purposes. The legal basis for processing your personal data is an agreement – Article 6 section 1 letter b) of the GDPR. Your personal data is also processed subject to a legitimate interest – Article 6 section 1 letter f) of the GDPR, where such interest involves promotion of own goods for marketing purposes, asserting claims and/or defence against any actual or potential claims.

In order to ensure collection of payments via the electronic payment service provider selected by you, Audioteka will share your personal data with that provider within the necessary extent. The list of available providers is enclosed on page [1]. Audioteka will not share your personal data with other recipients, except for those who have been requested to provide personal data processing services for and on behalf of Audioteka S.A., unless Audioteka is obliged to share such data following legal regulations. Entities who have been provided with your personal data for processing purposes fall into the category of suppliers of infrastructural solutions, and they may process your personal data in line with the GDPR in a third country. Such entities may also subcontract the processing of your personal data to other entities, who may be processing it in a third country. The list of processing entities is available on page [1].

Based on your behaviour within the Application, your actions and the data collected in that way, once you have provided an explicit consent, you may be sent automated, personalised offers. You can withdraw your consent at any time, however, this will be without prejudice to the legality of processing completed in line with your consent granted before it was revoked.

How long will we process your data for?

Your personal data will be processed for the duration of your use of the Application and for the term of the agreement as well as after its termination for a period allowing for the necessary defence of any rights.

What rights do you have?

You have the right to:

- access your personal data and receive copies of your data that is being processed;
- rectify any incorrect data;
- demand that your data be removed (the right to be forgotten) in the event of circumstances provided for in Article 17 of the GDPR;
- demand that the data processing be restricted in cases listed in Article 18 of the GDPR;
- object against the processing of your data in cases provided for in Article 21 of the GDPR;
- the portability of the data provided by you, which is processed in an automated way.

If in your opinion your personal data is processed against the law, you may lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority (Personal Data Protection Office, ul. 2 Stawki, Warsaw).
